

European 10,000m Cup Birmingham 2021

Medical Clearance and Sanitary Protocol as of 05 May 2021





In order to be able to host the European 10,000m Cup (the "Event") in Birmingham/GBR on 5 June 2021, the Local Organising Committee - in agreement with the Government Administration and European Athletics - developed the following set of **mandatory sanitary and medical rules and procedures**.

By registering (or being registered) for the Event, **you** (or the person you are registering) **agree(s) and commit(s) to strictly follow** these rules and procedures.

Violation of these rules and procedures may result in sanctions such as the revocation of the accreditation issued and prohibition of attending the Event.

<u>Note:</u> the sanitary and medical clearance procedures described in this document may change in accordance with the development of the COVID-19 pandemic situation in UK. Updates to the document would be circulated as necessary in due time.



General Information - UK

You must have proof of a negative COVID-19 test to travel to England from abroad 3 days before you travel.

UK Government has in place rules concerning restriction on international travel for non UK citizens. Countries designated as "red" list countries are subject to a 10-day quarantine on arrival.

There are no European Countries currently on this list. **However, should your country appears on this list, there will not be any exemption possible. Note** that what matters is the country where you come from (in the past 10 days) before participating in the European 10,000m Cup, not the country of citizenship.

Please ensure you check regular the list as this is subject to change at short notice

It is advised for the Team Leader to maintain a log of the seating plan of their delegation on the flight arriving to UK and transport to the event hotel in case of any problems to help the LOC with contract tracing protocols should they be required.



Sanitary Rules

- Wearing a mask covering the mouth and nose is obligatory at all times, except:
 - ✓ when seated at a table to have a meal (one must wear a mask if she/he leaves the table for any reason, even for a short period of time);
 - ✓ when eating/drinking (one must wear a mask when not eating/drinking);
 - ✓ When competing (athletes only!) i.e. until the athletes are on the Track and before entering the Live Mixed Zone
 - ✓ while doing active physical exercises during warm-up and training applies to athletes only!
- **Social distancing** of minimum 2m shall be strictly applied **at all times** (except in specific cases where it is not possible to maintain this policy (e.g. medical treatment, competition flow, etc.).
- If sharing a room and one tests positive they will be considered as contact and will need to isolate for 10 days
- Hand hygiene must be maintained with regular hand washing and the use of Alcohol Based Hand sanitiser

-48 HOURS PRIOR TO GOING BACK HOME

 RT-PCR Test for returning home if applicable




-72 HOURS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL TO BIRMINGHAM

Upon arrival - From the airport to the testing centre





Upon arrival at the airport:

Temperature check before boarding the bus

You will receive a "Sanitary Kit" including sufficient number of masks and handsanitizer.







In the bus to the Team Hotel testing centre:

Hand sanitation, 50% occupation capacity.








Stage 2

(at the LOC's cost if arrival more than 48hrs prior to competition/shared costs LOC-Member Federation if within departure requirement)

Stage 3 (at the LOC's cost) - All accredited people are required to repeat the RT-PCR test in case of arrival (and on site testing) to Birmingham before Thursday 3 June 08:00 CET) — To be reconfirmed once travel details are known

RE-TEST EVERY 48HRS DURING STAY – IF APPLICABLE



Not going to be re-tested will result in the deactivation of the accreditation



Stage 4 (at the Member Federation's costs) - if applicable and not conducted under Stage 2


